## **TOUR 2 LEONARDO** **Italian Educational & Cultural Experience**

**Tour Duration 16 days**  
**From AUD \$4,620**

**Day 1** Meet at International Airport at the check-in area for departure for Rome.

**Day 2 Rome (D)** Your tour leaders will meet you at Rome International Airport with your transfer to your hotel. We will be holding a sign with your school name. Your hotel is in the centre of Rome where you will check-in and have time to freshen up or have a rest. Before dinner, we will guide you on a leisurely stroll through some of the famous 'piazze' of Rome. The guided walking tour will include Piazza della Repubblica, Fountain of Trevi, Piazza della Rotonda, Piazza Navona and finally Campo de' Fiori. The walk will end with an early dinner in a traditional Roman restaurant.

**Day 3 Rome/Vatican (BD)** After breakfast we continue to enjoy and experience more of the fascinating sites of Rome. We start with the important Monument to Vittorio Emanuele, Campidoglio and the Mayoral Offices. Also, your tour leaders will take the group through Ancient Rome, visiting the Roman Forum, followed by a special visit to the Colosseum. In the afternoon there will be a guided tour of St Peters Basilica, important for religious, architectural and historical reasons. Dinner in a traditional restaurant.

**Day 4 Rome/Tivoli/Educational Language School Umbria (BD)** Today will be an early morning start. Our tour bus will take us north to the Region of Umbria which will be our stay for the next five nights. On the way we make a stop at Tivoli just outside Rome for a guided visit of Villa d'Este and Hadrian's Villa. We should reach the school by late afternoon where the group will be welcomed by the principal teachers of the school who will give a brief explanation of the activities for the coming days. The students will then be introduced to the families they will be staying with for the duration of their Italian language experience. Dinner will be with their billeted family.

**Day 5/8 Language School (BD)** For the next four days students will attend classes from 9:00am to 1:00pm with a 20 minute break around mid morning. In the afternoons they will be attending a variety of activities, for example:

- Guided visits to Perugia and Orvieto
- Visits to local important cultural and historical sites, museums, galleries and markets
- Traditional Italian pizza making cooking lesson in a local agriturismo
- Ceramic workshop where students will learn the ancient techniques of this famous art form.

**\*\* Activities will vary depending on the educational school you choose. \*\***

We have internationally recognised schools in Milano, Florence, Venice, Orvieto, Pescara, Pesaro/Urbino, Padova & Taormina in Sicily.

**Day 9 Language School/Siena/San Gimignano/Florence (BD)** Today our journey takes us through some of the richest parts of the Italian countryside and on to Florence, the city of the Medici. On the way to Florence there will be a special visit to Siena to admire the Cathedral and the Piazza del Campo, one of the most beautiful squares in Europe and learn about the famous race '*Il Palio*'. Also along the way there will be a stop in San Gimignano. A tiny historical city perched on a hill, famous for its numerous towers and art treasures. There we will also visit a *gelateria* which has won numerous world titles for its home made ice cream and is regarded as the best *gelato* in the world. After our arrival in Florence, the group will check in at the hotel and the rest of the day will include a walking tour, which features Piazza del Duomo and its cathedral with the Giotto Campanile and the magnificent East Door of the Baptistery known as the '*Gates of Paradise*'. Dinner at a restaurant in the centre of Florence.

**Day 10 Florence (BD).** Our second day in Florence starts with a visit to the Academy Gallery to admire the original David by Michelangelo and other masterpieces by this great artist. The tour continues to the Piazza della Signoria with the famous Uffizi Gallery and Ducal Palace. In the afternoon you are free to wander through the famous markets shopping for leather and gold goods or leisurely explore this beautiful city. There will also be free time to explore other historical sights such as Ponte Vecchio, the church of Santa Croce renowned for its frescoes and tombs of some of Italy's famous artists or for student teacher activities. Dinner at a local restaurant.

**Day 11 Florence/Pisa (BD)** Today we make a special trip to one of Italy's most famous landmarks, the Leaning Tower of Pisa, one of several architecturally important structures in the Piazza dei Miracoli. The Leaning Tower, built in 1173, is the campanile, or the bell tower, of the Cathedral, famous for its noticeable lean. In the afternoon we make our way back to Florence by train. Your tour guide will give the group the opportunity to climb Giotto's famous tower of the Duomo and experience a magnificent view of all of Florence. Dinner in a traditional restaurant in Florence.

**Day 12 Florence/Venice (BD)** After breakfast we travel to Venice on the Eurostar. Upon arrival in Venice we take a *vaporetto* ride along the Grand Canal to check into our hotel. We have the afternoon to experience the sights of Venice including Piazza San Marco and the Basilica, the Bridge of Sigh, Ducal Palace and the Rialto Bridge. We then walk back through the small streets of Venice to our hotel for dinner.

**Day 13 Venice/Murano (BD)** Today after breakfast we take in the sights again along the Grand Canal to the island of Murano where Venice's world famous glass is made and visit several glassblowers creating their masterpieces. In the afternoon the group will enjoy a tour of a world renowned workshop that specialises in the production and decoration of traditional Venetian masks. Here the students will attend a special demonstration and course where they will try their hand at traditional Venetian mask making. Dinner at the hotel.

**Day 14 Venice (B)** Today after breakfast the group departs for Venice Airport for the flight back to Australia.

**Day 15/16** Arrival back in Australia.
